Year 1 Using the split diagraph e-e
Eg Pete, theme, these, complete

Year 2 the 'ur' sound spelt 'o' after 'w'
The apostrophe shows where a letter or letters would be if the words were written in full
Eg word, worm, world

Year 3 Prefix 'mis'
Most prefixes are added to the beginning of words without any change in spelling. 'Mis' has a negative meaning.
Eg Misbehave, mislead, misspell

Year 4 Plurals—revision
RULE #3
If words end in a consonant + 'y' then get rid of the 'y' and add 'ies'
Eg puppies, cranberries, armies
